Roles and Responsibilities

AHS Clinical Nurse Educator or Nurse Clinician

All HCW/staff are responsible to review and be familiar with the <u>Guide for Outbreak Prevention</u> <u>& Control in Provincial Correctional Centres</u> and site-specific processes. This checklist is used in combination with those resources to outline the roles and responsibilities for the AHS Clinical Nurse Educator or Nurse Clinician before, during and after an outbreak. These actions help protect everyone at the centre and ensure a coordinated response.
