

# Diapering Procedure



## 1. Get supplies ready

- Change table equipped with a belt
- Hand sink with soap & paper towel
- Diaper, baby wipes, applicators & creams
- Sanitizing solution (labelled for diapering)
- Paper liner



## 2. Place the child on the clean change surface

Place the child on the paper and fasten the safety belt. Never leave the child unattended. Remove and discard soiled diaper.



## 3. Clean the child's skin and apply the diaper

Clean skin with a single-use towel, wiping from **front to back**.

If applying ointment, use a single use applicator for ointments or creams.



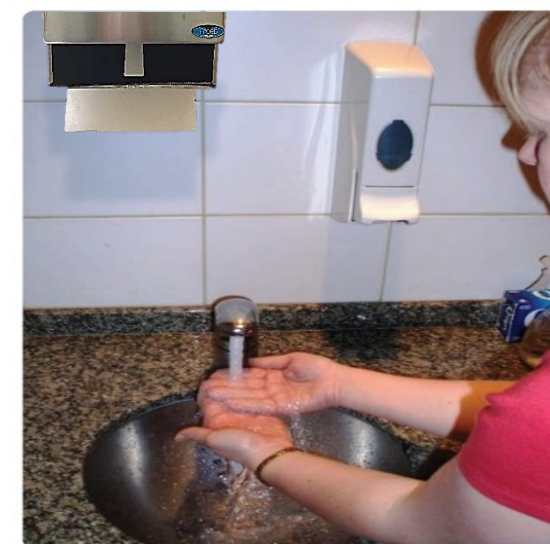
## 4. Dress child, wash and dry hands with paper towel



## 5. Clean & disinfect the change surface

If there is visible contamination, first clean the surface with hot water and soap.

**Make a sanitizer** by adding 2 ml (1/2 teaspoon) household bleach per liter (4 cups) of water or approved 0.5% accelerated hydrogen peroxide.



## 6. Wash your hands with soap and warm water
