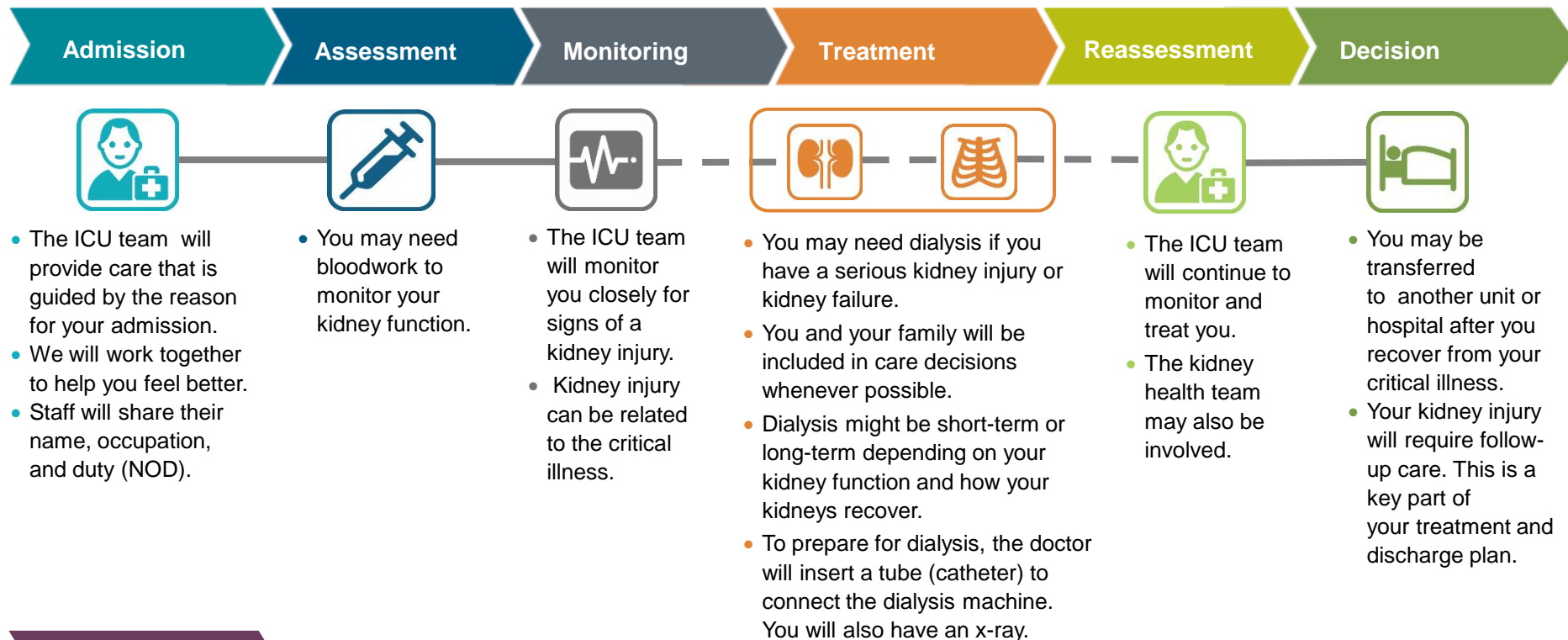


Kidney dialysis in the ICU - Patient Journey Map

"ICU can feel hopeless and trapped and mechanical when you're surrounded by equipment that's beeping and flashing. Human connection is important."

"Going to the dialysis machine every other day makes you feel terrible and tired. It can be hard to have the conversations about dialysis when you're that sick."



"The presence of someone living with dialysis gives people hope. Peer support can help with this."
