Offer guidance and support in a positive way 2:1 Technique/Feedback Sandwich- give 2 positive feedback comments for every 1 opportunity for improvement Feedback Sandwich: start and end with a positive feedback comment, opportunity for improvement in the middle. 	Key learnings Remind staff that as a PPE Safety Coach- Your role is to observe and support safe PPE practices
