Women's Health Ambulatory Care clinics offer a range of health services which are delivered at the Foothills Medical Centre campus. Our patient and family centered approach includes individualized assessment and information from trusted health providers.

Pelvic Floor Clinic

Offering assessment and treatment for women with bladder or bowel control concerns, and pelvic organ prolapse

- Assessment by Urogynecologists, family physicians, nurse practitioner, advance practice CNS and RNs
- Patient workshops: in-house and online education
- Medical, surgical, and conservative treatment options including pessary fitting
- Physiotherapy assessment and treatment – by internal referral only

Calgary Breast Health Program

Outpatient clinic with health professionals offering assessment and diagnosis for women with breast health issues (excluding those related to breast feeding).

- Assessment by breast surgeons and breast experts who investigate, provide treatment options and management of benign breast disease
- Breast cancer risk assessment services for women with genetic or familial risk factors
- Surgical treatment for breast cancer
- Nurse Navigation support and resource information for patients and families
- Coordination of care between community health providers and surgeons
