Clean & Active Transportation

The Green Hospital Scorecard assesses our site's Clean and Active Transportation.

Active transportation is using one's own power to get from one place to another and includes walking, jogging and biking. Clean transportation includes public transit, carpooling, shuttles and lowemission vehicles.



RGH supports **Clean and Active Transportation**:

- Parking Services staff parking on site have the option to temporarily suspend parking for seasonal or alternate commuting.
- Calgary Transit buses stop at RGH entrance points in addition

 Bicycling – to support RGH staff commuting by bicycle, bike racks are easily accessible at site entry points. Secure bike lockers are available inside the Lot 1 parkade and at the Emergency Entrance at no charge to staff. As of October 2022, 1,169 employees at RGH have requested access to bike lockers.
