

In 2022-2023, Central Zone Clinical Operations made re-establishing hand hygiene compliance reviews and reporting a zone priority. The Central Zone IPC Hand Hygiene Program worked with site leadership, quality consultants and accreditation advisors to prepare for the Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 Accreditation Survey visits. The IPC hand hygiene project manager prepared hand hygiene dashboard reports for accreditation workbooks. New site based reviewers were recruited and trained. New programs were added to the Clean Hands System including Public Health, Rehabilitation Medicine, and Addictions & Mental Health.
