
## Your A Moments for Hand Hygiene



1	BEFORE contact with patient/patient's environment	Why? To protect the patient against harmful germs carried on your hands Example: Before contacting a patient
2	BEFORE clean/aseptic procedure	Why? To protect the patient against harmful germs from entering their body Example: Before providing dental or oral care
3	AFTER body fluid exposure risk	Why? To protect yourself and the health care environment from harmful germs Example: After providing dental or oral care
4	AFTER contact with patient/patient's environment	Why? To protect yourself and the health care environment from harmful germs Example: After contacting a patient
