Transport staff only don PPE if assisting with care. Select PPE based on the Additional Precaution sign.

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Additional Information

- a. Always perform hand hygiene before and after transporting a patient. Use soap and water when transporting a patient on Contact & Sporicidal Precautions.
- b. If wearing PPE to prepare a patient for transport, discard the used PPE and perform hand hygiene before transport. Put on clean PPE for direct patient contact at the destination.

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c. If a patient on Droplet or Airborne Precautions is unable to tolerate a surgical mask during transport, consult Infection Prevention and Control.
