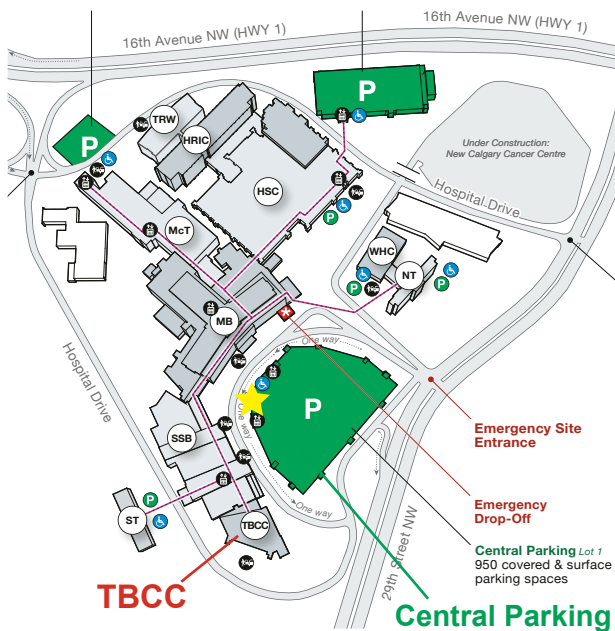

- Behind building, basement level, radiation treatment

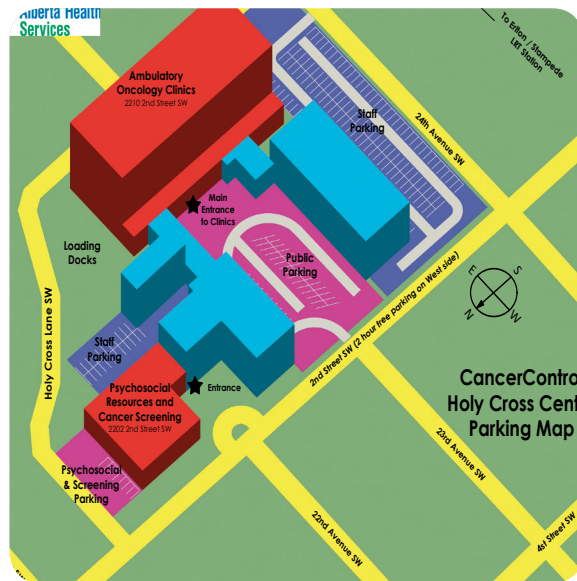

General Information

Your First Clinic Visit

Your first visit will be at **either**:

- **Holy Cross Centre**
- **Tom Baker Cancer Centre**

After you check in and pick up your ID card, you will meet with a doctor and nurse from your care team. You will have a chance to discuss details about your cancer and treatment options.


You may need to have more blood tests, x-rays or other tests.

Before you leave, we may arrange more appointments for treatments or other cancer care.

Information for Newly Diagnosed Cancer Patients

If you have been told you have cancer we have a book available to help you. Our **Newly Diagnosed with Cancer** book has information about what to expect, questions to ask and available supports and resources. We recommend viewing it before you come, if possible. A paper copy will be offered to you at your visit.

Preparing for Your First Visit

- Eat a good meal — your visit may take from 2–4 hours
- Bring a close family member or friend for company and support, if you can. (Please note, **no more than 2 people may come with you** into the exam rooms).
- Bring all of your health care cards with you:
 - Picture ID card
 - Provincial Health Care card
 - Blue Cross and/or other health insurance cards (if any)
- Write a list of medications and other supplements you are taking and bring it with you to your appointment. 
- Download a medication form: myhealth.alberta.ca (search “medication list”).
- If you do not have a list completed, please bring all of your medications with you in a bag, including all prescribed medications, off-the-shelf drugs and vitamins or supplements.
- Find a checklist of items to bring in the **orange section** of the **Newly Diagnosed with Cancer** book.



Parking Information

Tom Baker Cancer Centre Parking

Lot 1 is the closest lot to park in. See the back page “Getting There” section.

Come early so you have enough time to park and walk, or get dropped off at the front or back of the building.

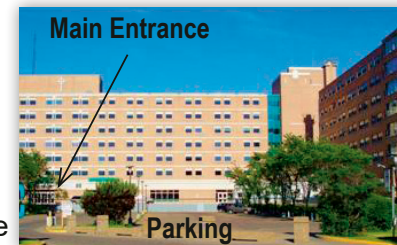
You can pay with credit cards or coins. You will need your license plate number when you pay for parking.

Holy Cross Centre Parking

There is a large pay parking area (wheelchair accessible) in front of the main entrance (see map on back page; it is the large pink area).



Pay for your parking at the machine outside or inside the lobby. You can pay with credit cards or coins. A change machine is available inside the lobby.

You will need your license plate number when you pay for parking. If you are in your appointment and need to add on time, call 403-828-7337.

Some free, 2-hour street parking or metered parking is available in the area. Please read the signs carefully.
