
AHS COGNITIVE SCREEN ALGORITHM (Dementia/MCI)

(Not meant to be prescriptive but used only to guide clinical reasoning)

MCI – Mild Cognitive Impairment Lang – language Dx – diagnosis FTD – Fronto-temporal Dementia

If the client has a concurrent neurological dx and communication issues, the clinician may want to consider using the Oxford Cognitive Screen.

*The ACE III requires more time to complete and was not meant to be comparable to the SLUMS as a replacement for the MoCA



- 1. Reasons for cognitive screening include: to detect cognitive impairment, identify need for further testing, potential to track progress and initial step in triage. It is assumed delirium has been ruled out.
- 2. Consider use of translator.
