

Patient Instructions 2 hour Glucose Tolerance or 2 hour Pregnant Glucose Tolerance or Gestational Diabetes Screen

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How to Prepare	Contact your local Laboratory Collection site to determine if an appointment is required.	
	 2 hour Glucose Tolerance and 2 hour Pregnant Glucose Tolerance - Requires an 8 hour fast. 	
	Gestational Diabetic Screen – Recommend a 4 hour fast, but not required.	
	 Fasting is defined as nothing to eat, chew, or drink except small amounts or water. 	
	 Prescription medication and smoking is permitted prior to your appointment. 	
Risks or	Be prepared to stay at the Laboratory Collection site for the duration of the test,	
Cautions	approximately two to three hours .	
Collecting the Sample	 You will be given a glucose drink; we encourage you to finish the drink within 5 minutes. 	
	During the test one, two or three blood samples may be taken.	
	 You will be required to remain in the laboratory collection area for the entire duration of the test. 	
	You will not be allowed to eat, chew, or smoke.	
	You may use the washroom.	
	You may have a small amount of water if needed.	
	Notify the laboratory staff if you feel nauseous, lightheaded or unwell during the test.
